Classroom Supplies:

Emergency Backpack

Classroom Lockdown Kit

- 1 – Whistle
- 1 – 10 yd. Roll Duct Tape
- 1 – Large Mylar Blanket

- Pre-written responses for media inquiries

Reunification Team:

- Directional Signage
- Caution Tape

Logistics / Long Term Care Team:

- Tents, Tarps, and Shelters
- Outdoor Lighting
- N95 Dust masks for all faculty, staff, and students
- Toilet buckets with plastic bags and deodorizers
- Toilet seat covers
- Privacy Shelter (1 per toilet)
- Toilet paper
- Feminine Supplies
- Wet wipes
- Plastic trash bags
- Comfort Items: such as games and activities for students
